

PHBI 550—Seminar in Systems Biology and Disease Spring 2007

PHBI 550 - Seminar in Systems Biology and Disease will be offered this spring term. This 1-unit course will meet once a week for 1 hr. This course is limited to students in SBD, PHBI and PATH.

The seminar has two aims: to help students optimize their presentation skills and to provide students with critical input from their peers and faculty about their ongoing work. Students will have the opportunity to make a presentation relevant to the research in their lab: junior students will present proposals of the work they plan to do and more senior students will present their ongoing research.
